## PE Kit

For all children, PE kits are to be worn into school. ## Spectating events

Each event will have an area designated for parents/carers to spectate and we ask that you only use these areas to observe each event – these will be clearly marked. We have told the children that they are not to cross the track to meet with you, therefore we ask you not to encourage your child to do so either. We thank you for your understanding and support on this matter.

## End of the Day

After the final races, the children will then be sent back to their classes. You can then collect your child as usual at the end of the school day. If your child usually walks home unaccompanied, they will be dismissed from the classroom.
